Ada County Victim Services Center is a safe place where victims and their families are treated with dignity and respect and where they receive comprehensive, compassionate, and healing services.

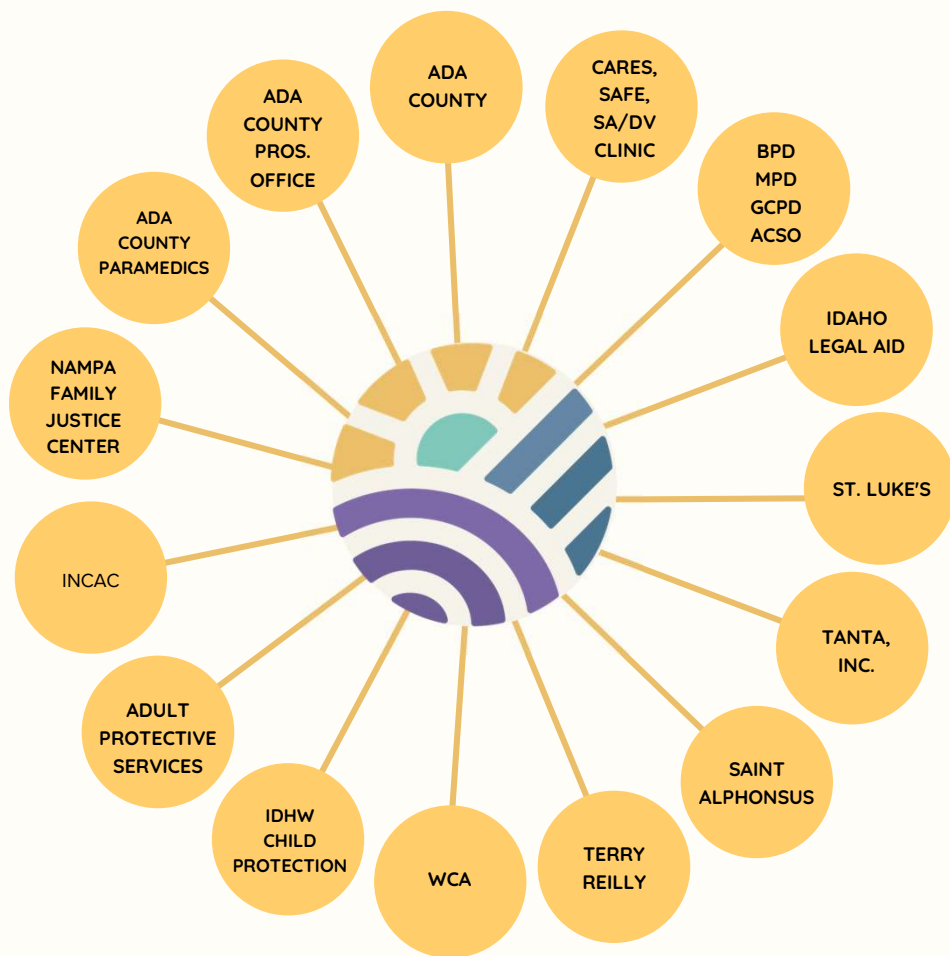


Who do we help?
