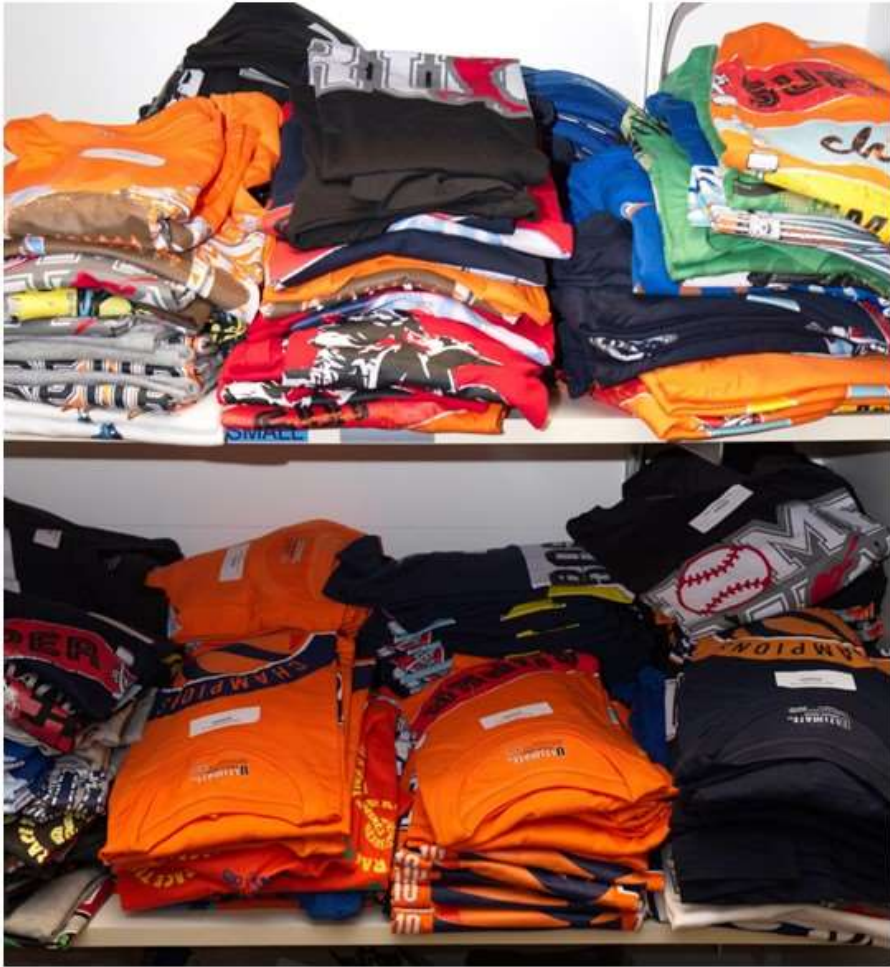

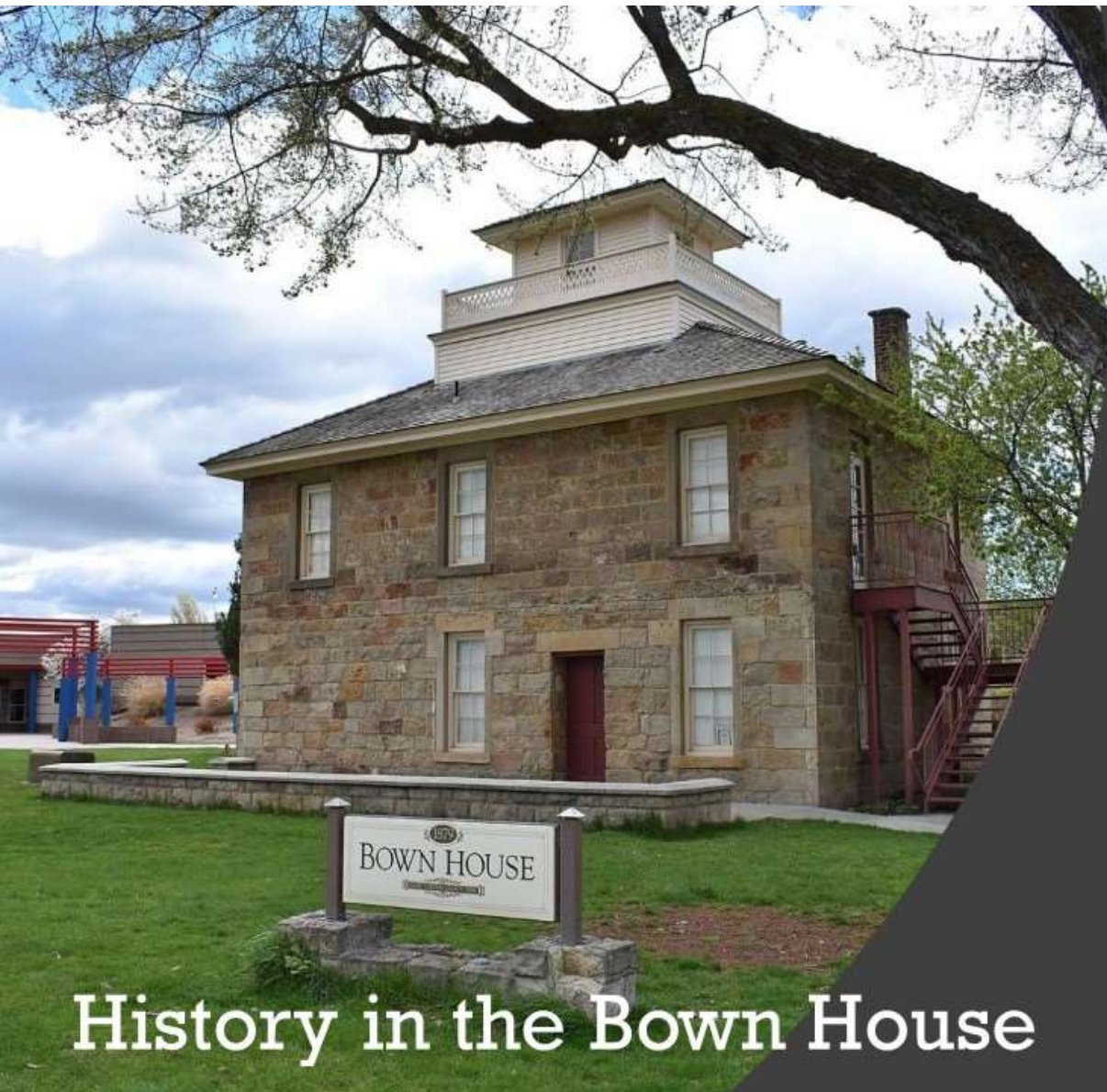

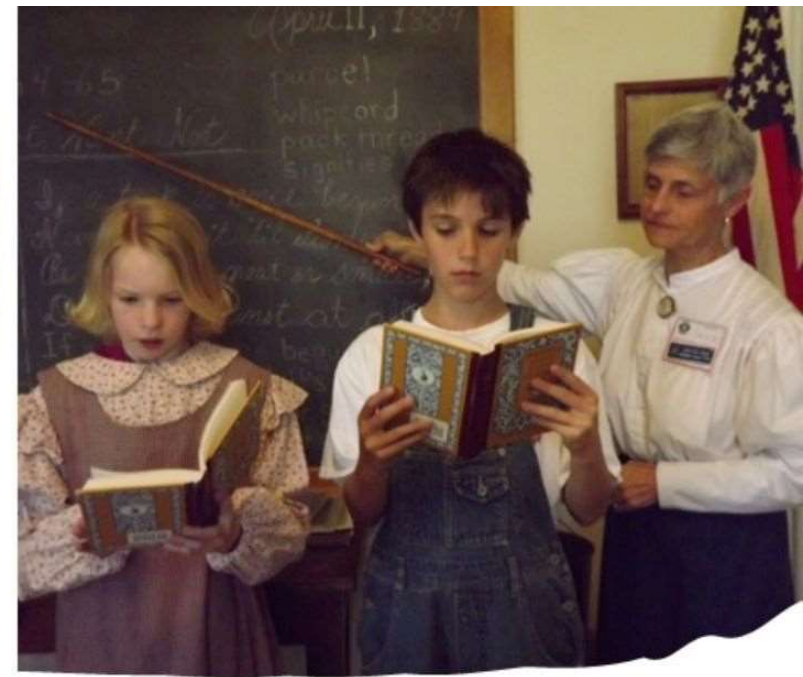

Mon-Tues 1-3pm



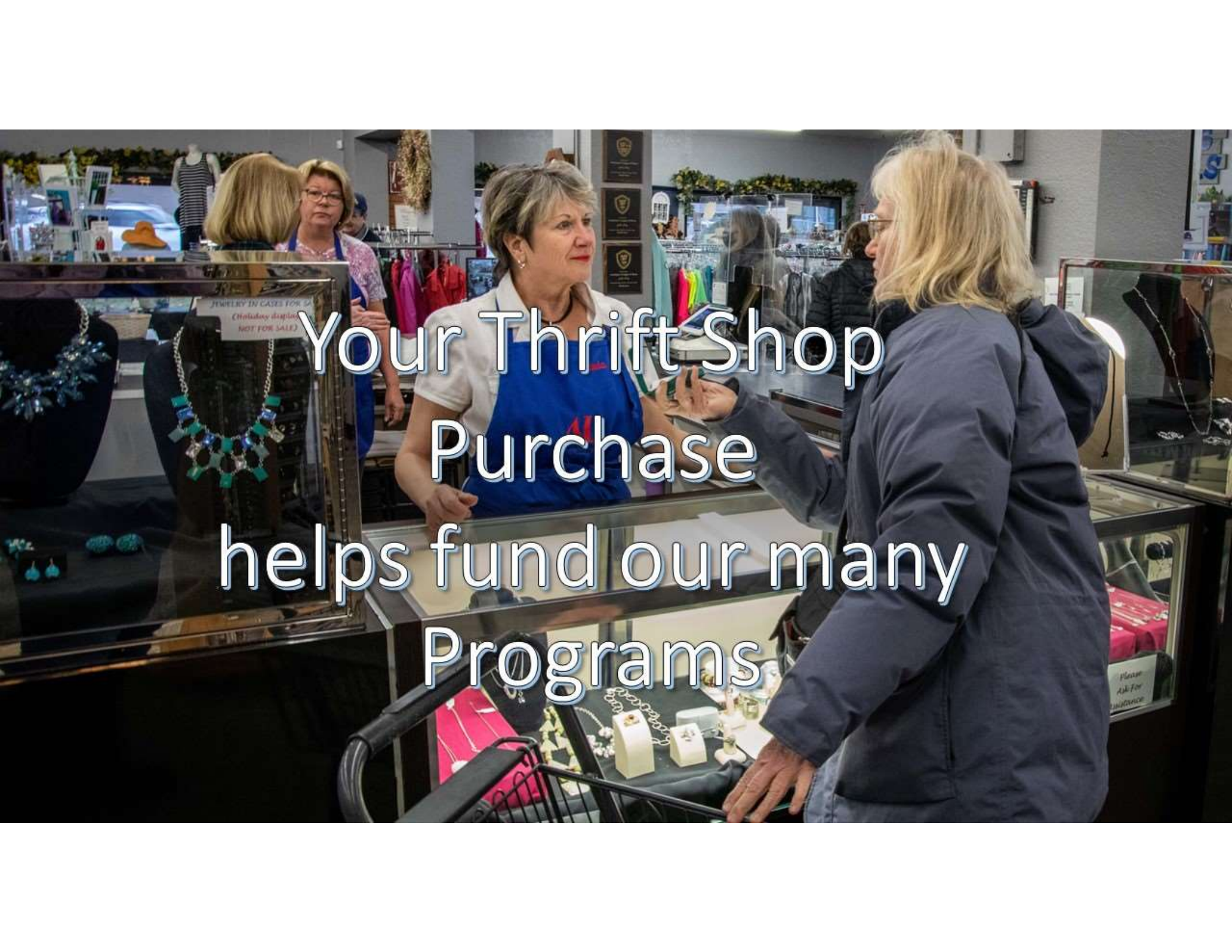
