Our program works with low-income families in need of home repairs and modifications.

The types of repairs we focus on include:

- Accessibility
 - Wheelchair ramps
 - Grab bars
- Critical Repairs



How to apply

You do not have to be a Habitat homeowner to apply for repairs.

Stop by the Boise Valley Habitat for Humanity office at 9438 W. Fairview Avenue Boise, ID 83704 to pick up a Home Repairs Pre-application form, or go to our website.

You can also give us a call at (208) 331-2916 and we can send you an application via mail or email.

After application

Our staff review each application and approves projects based on funding and capacity. Once approved, the project is added to our potential project list.

Our Home Repairs program manager will be in contact with homeowners to set up an at-home visit. If the project fits within the scope of the program, the project will be officially added to our repair list and will be scheduled based on weather and volunteers.

The total cost will only be a percent of the project based on the homeowner's income bracket.
